The successful candidate will be expected to have a PhD in Mathematics and must have a research record at an international level in Number Theory, noting the preference for applicants whose work will relate to and strengthen existing areas of interest in the Number Theory group at Oxford, together with the ability and experience to teach effectively over a wide range of topics in the undergraduate and MSc mathematics syllabus at Oxford, not exclusively in the area of his or her research expertise, and has the skills to provide tutorial teaching in pure mathematics.
